

## Super Silicon

What's underneath Don Johnsons's victory in the World Championships; the trans-Atlantic speed record attempts of Gentry and Azimut, and Kiwi Magic's impressive racing in the 1987 America's Cup? Kiss-Cote, a polymerized silicon formula invented by Dr. Keith Kent of Florida, is on all these winners' hulls. Kiss-Cote does three major things that boat owners can't argue with: It increases speed, reduces fuel consumption and lowers maintenance costs. A little goes a long way: Eight grams (pictured) will coat a smooth hull. Simply buff on. spread to coat the surface and wipe off the excess. No primer is necessary.
